What: A Study of the new HPV Vaccine! HPV (Human papillomavirus) is the name of a group of viruses that includes more than 100 different types. More than 30 of these viruses are sexually transmitted and some may lead to cancer of the cervix (the lower part of the uterus that connects with the vagina). A multi-ethnic study of mothers and their daughters entitled PDAC: Mothers Protecting Daughters Against Cancer.

Why: To explore the knowledge, attitudes, and intentions of mothers with early teen daughters regarding the new HPV vaccine
